PROJECT SCOPE

This project provides for approximately 2 miles of new roadway alignment that includes construction of a bridge over active railroad tracks, and an 8' wide Shared Use path. The Project also provides for the tie-in to an existing 4-lane highway with a signalized intersection. Besides design and construction, this project comprises of utility relocation and coordination along with permit application, and acquisition and mitigation costs.
